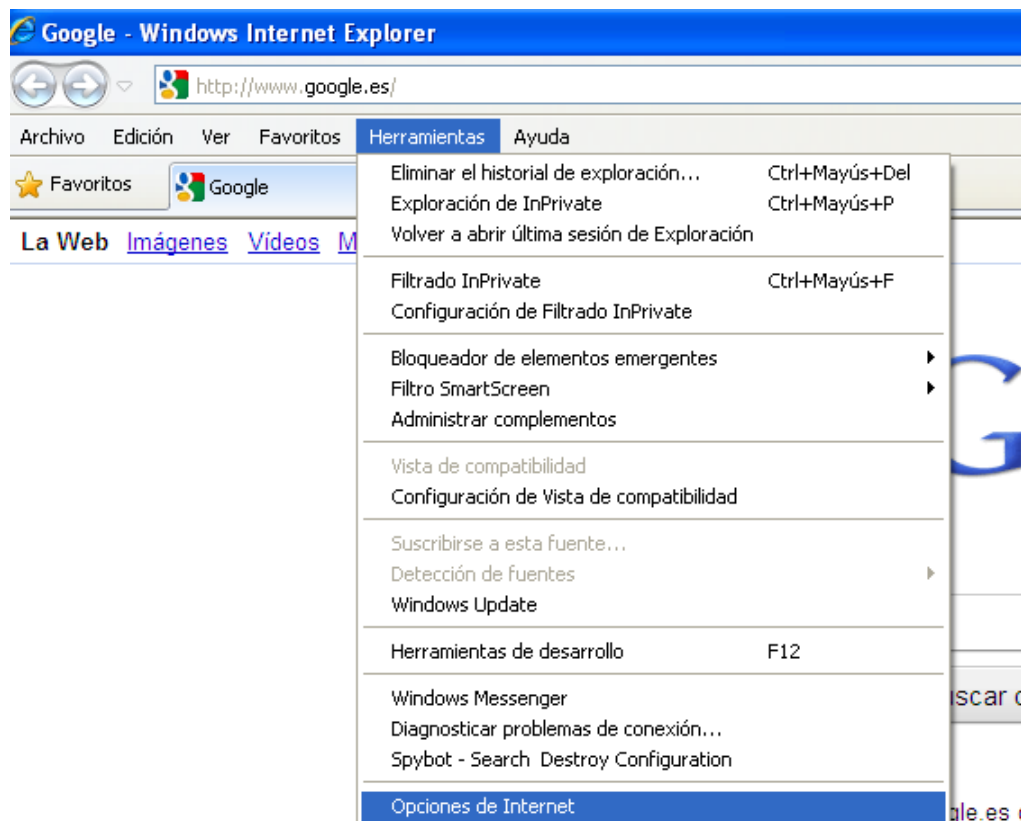
## Exporting certificates from Internet Explorer

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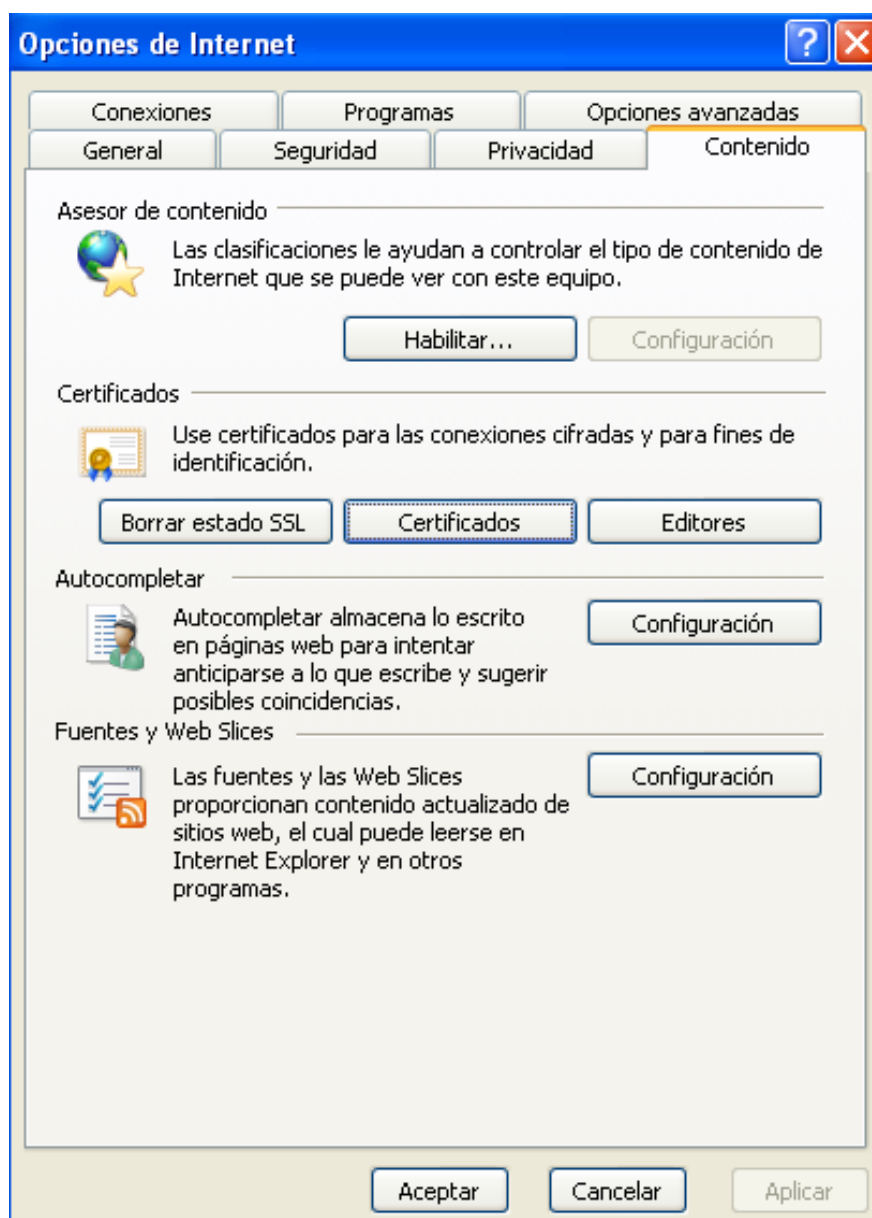

## Exporting a software-based certificate

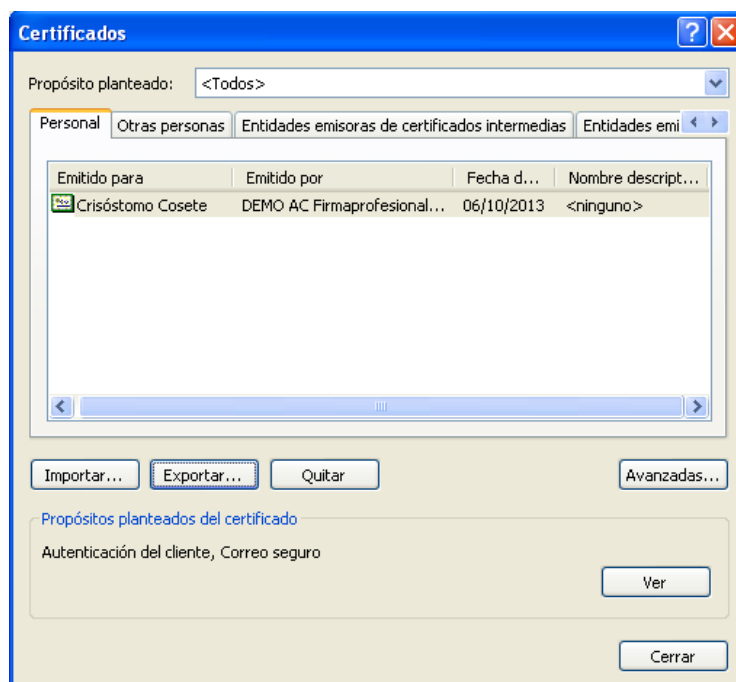
After you obtain your personal certificate, you should export it to a secure location. Open Internet Explorer. Click on the “Tools” menu and then “Internet Options”. In the next window, click the “Content” tab, and then the “Certificates” button.



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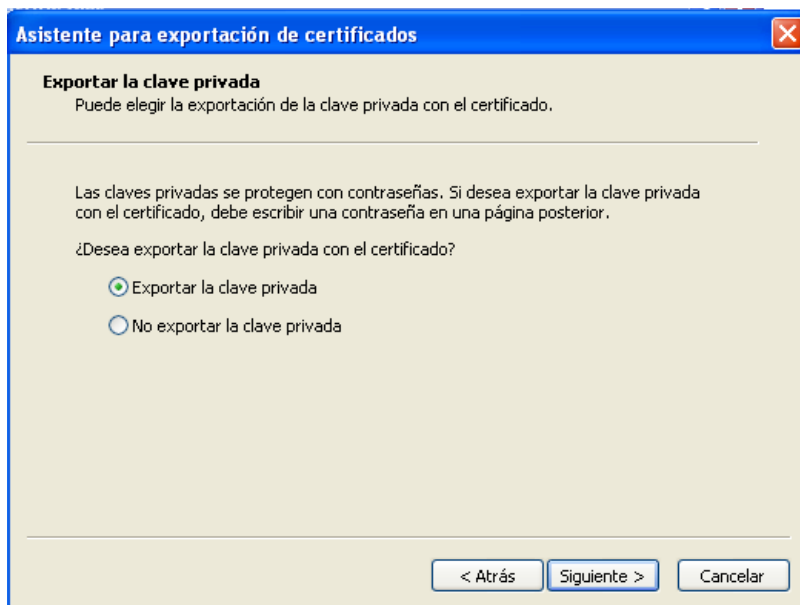
The certificates that are installed in Internet Explorer will then be displayed. Select the certificate that you want to export and click “Export”



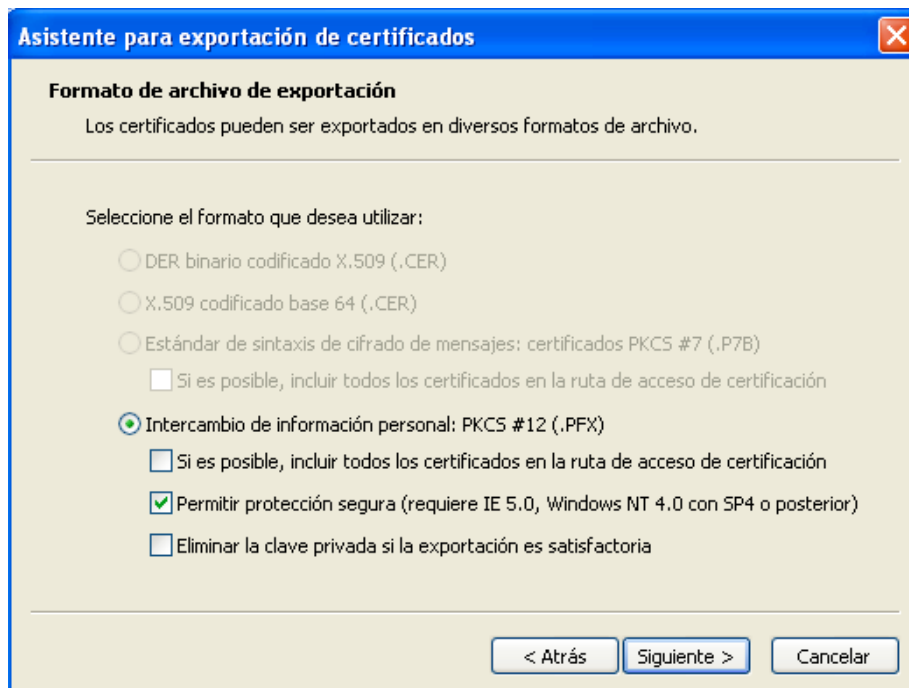
A new window will open. Click “Next”.




In the next window, select “Export private key” and then “Next”



Mark “Allow secure protection” and then “Next”.




Enter a password for your certificate. This password will be required when the certificate is imported.

Select where you would like to export the certificate and give it a name. Now click “Save”.
